Award recipients receive a \$500 cash award and a commemorative plaque. The award is supported through a grant from the Foundation for California Community Colleges.

The California Community Colleges is the largest higher education system in the nation comprised of 72 districts and 110 colleges with more than 2.7 million students per year. Community colleges supply workforce training and basic skills education, prepare students for transfer to four-year institutions and offer opportunities for personal enrichment and lifelong learning.
